



Au2mate Academy, in cooperation with Branderup Dairy, has completed the course "Get familiar with your control system" in order for operators to get a greater knowledge about the control system of the dairy and thus be better at troubleshooting when undesired stops occur in the production. The purpose is to achieve an improved uptime.

THE PURPOSE IS IMPROVED UPTIME

The idea behind the course "Get familiar with your control system" is to educate the operators, so that it will be easier for them to troubleshoot in emergency situations. Is it a component failure or an operating error? Is it necessary to get hold of a technician who can fix the fault on the component that fails, or where is the fault?

CONTENT OF COURSE - DAY 1 - ACADEMY

The course takes place over two days, where day 1 takes place in the Au2mate Academy and day 2 takes place at Branderup Dairy.

At the Au2mate Academy you are taught the basic principles for the building of Arla's control systems. Ranging from S88 to PI diagrams and how a control system is structured; including program descriptions, process cell structure, unit descriptions, blocking, state transition, alarms, setpoints, cross fields.

How to operate the control system, alarms and events, including follow-up alarms and operator event searches. Start-up after service shutdown. How to start after a fault. Components are studied to gain greater understanding of e.g. valves, including valve seat lift.

PROCESS AUTOMATION PARTNER

Throughout the afternoon, the focus is on troubleshooting. The instructor makes real faults on the Academy pilot plant, which the operators must find through the tools they have learned to use.

CONTENT OF COURSE - DAY 2 - BRANDERUP

On day 2 the operators will be trained in their own control system. Naturally, focusing on the special things that are particularly relevant for Branderup, and again much work is done on troubleshooting, alarms and events, in order that the operators feel better equipped for quickly identifying faults.

After the course, the operator has a greater understanding of how the control system, the components and the process are connected and will with more peace of mind be able to find the current fault faster and start the process again.
